

I would like to take this opportunity to share my experience at this lovely church. I am really thankful to God for leading me and I give all this glory to God. While I was in training in "Prayer Crusade", the pastor said that there is currently 3300 tribes around the world that are still unreached and we should pray for them. I realized that Port Bolster town needs God's word and love and I would start praying for them and share God's words. I prayed "Lord please fix me first and let me be filled with your glory so I can share your words and tell them how amazing you are. I will evangelize 100 people sharing four spiritual laws."

Until today, I shared the four spiritual laws with 160 people and I am not going to stop until every single person in Port Bolster has heard of God's words. I had a lot of different experiences through evangelizing. There was a parent who got mad when I spoke to their child about Jesus without their permission and came back to me with the bible I gave them. At that time I was very shocked and sad and disappointed; however I am used to it now. I am really excited to see who God will send me every day.

While sharing the four spiritual laws, I was touched by how strong and amazing God is. A couple of weeks ago, I was evangelizing a disabled person, and when he accepted Christ, I was lost for words. One time, I was sharing the four spiritual laws to a drug dealer, but I felt very uncomfortable and afraid, and that night I could not go to sleep. I told my church members to pray for Port Bolster and myself. Next morning, while I was doing morning prayer, God gave me this verse, *"For last night an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I serve stood beside me, and he said, 'Don't be afraid, Paul, for you will surely stand trial before Caesar! What's more, God in his goodness has granted safety to everyone sailing with you.' So take courage! For I believe God. It will be just as he said."* (Act 27:23-25) As I read that verse, it gave me strength and faith.

Last summer I was ill with Shingles. I could not eat or sleep. There was too much pain and I just hoped that I could go to sleep. I could not get more than a couple hours of good sleep. However, I realized that nothing is comparable to Jesus dying on the cross for our sins. I shared the four spiritual laws with this boy named J. Anderson. I knew this young man since I moved to Port Bolster. He was a really good kid and always positive. When I heard he had cancer I really wanted share God's words. I was really thankful that he accepted Christ.

A couple of weeks ago, one of our neighbors passed away from a drug overdose. As soon as I heard that I looked at my evangelism list and his name wasn't there. I had a chance to share God's words, but now it is too late, I was very ashamed of myself. Also, when I first moved to Port Bolster town, there was this woman named Catherin. She told me that she only has 6 months left to live. I really wanted to share God's word so I wrote a letter and prepared a few bible verses, but I heard that she was in a coma. She could not even survive one month and had passed away. I was late again and I didn't have the chance to give her the letter and the bible verses.

Now, I am really thankful to God for giving me people to share God's love and word. I don't know how to say this but it's amazing how God is working on us. Everything is planned out by God and nothing could work without God. I have been living the way I wanted to live but for the rest of my life, I want to live my life for God. So I have been praying for the next 10 years of my life. I will walk the way God will lead me. There is Intercession for Port Bolster town and this church every Sunday and Wednesday. Please pray for us. Prayer is the only way that things can change. Recently, I have been losing weight a lot and I cannot eat or sleep very well. Please pray for me. Thank you to Cedardale Church for giving me an opportunity to share this.

I have been sharing the gospel with my neighbors since October 30, 2009. I analyzed 160 as of today; those receiving Christ - 107(68%), thinking about it - 23 (14%) , denying His gift - 30(18%).

When I attended an evangelism seminar, one speaker told us, we need to pray a hedge around my neighbors and we should tell the gospel to them. Why don't we try? We are ambassadors for Jesus Christ.

Now I tell the gospel to more than one person every single day. This is a daily routine and my daily purpose. I call it Shindler's spiritual list.
